

MARCH 2022



He emphasized that in order to help more and more Jain youth to become Civil Services officers and participate in Nation Building, JATF has enhanced its hostel capacities. Now, it is the responsibility of the entire JITO & JATF fraternity not only to help get quality candidates in required quantities but also to help identify and motivate donors to contribute towards this noble cause.

JATF President Shri Anil Jain set the context for the meeting. He emphasized that JATF is a project of JITO. The separate entity is just for ease of administration purpose. Thus, it's a baby of entire JITO fraternity and require support from all. He appraised all about JATF's more than 500 Civil Services Officers across India. He updated all about JATF's Mission 1000 and Mission 100. Mission 1000 means getting 1000 students admitted in JATF hostels every year. Mission 100 means helping 100 young aspirants to become Civil Services officers year on year. Mission 100 also means to add on 100 Patrons every year to support the noble cause of JATF. He explained about the enhanced capacities of JATF hostels and also highlighted the importance of careers in Civil Services, Banking Services, Judiciary Services, IIT. He emphasized that Jain youth should come forward and chose these career options and also contribute in Nation Building. He also praised JITO Belgaum and Hubli Chapter for propagating JATF through awareness programs. He requested JITO to treat 'propagation of JATF' as a separate criterion for evaluating annual performance of JITO Chapters and assign some points for the same.





He updated about the responses JATF get for online registration for its Common Entrance Test (CET) for admissions to JATF hostels for above streams and expressed need for reaching out to aspirants of all these services from every nook and corner of India and create awareness and interest among them so that they can come forward and do online registration for CET 2022 scheduled on Sunday 8th May 2022. He also informed that the online registration for JATF CET-2022 is open till 28th April 2022 at www.jatfadmission.org

JATF Chairman Shri Hemant Jain explained the importance of careers in Civil Services, Banking Services, Judiciary Services and IIT from individual's as well as nation's point of view. He updated all that at present, around 15% percent of UPSC officers from open category every year are from JATF. With cooperation of all, it may be taken to 25% level. He appealed all JITO/JATF dignitaries to spread a word among community members from their areas about facilities JATF offer to Jain youths to fulfil their career dreams and motivate them to take up these career options and do online registration for JATF CET. He also appealed all to help those candidates who were not successful in cracking UPSC exam by offering them suitable jobs.

JITO Apex President Shri Suresh Mutha congratulated JATF team for this unique initiative. He emphasized need for better integration among JITO and JATF. 
JITO JUHU | ANALYSIS ON UNION BUDGET 2022-23
