# THE NEED FOR JAIN REPOSITORY OF DOCTORS

## WHAT IS THE VALUE PROPOSITION OF JITO FOR DOCTORS?

- Lots of members of JITO, their families, their employees & their network need to find out specialist doctors based on the health problem they face. Being able to find appropriate specialist doctors in the given city or other cities/countries becomes quite critical for that JITO member. JITO is working on creating a technology platform where details and specialty of the doctors and their affiliations with hospitals etc. details will be displayed. When any member asks for the appropriate doctor to match their requirements, this platform (supported by JITO Secretariat) will give names of the required specialists doctors to that member.
- Doctors will get recognition & acknowledgement when their profiles will get listed on JITO's technology platform
- JITO has 8 projects under its umbrella & 3 wings which include JITO Ladies, JITO Youth & JITO International. Each project can add distinct value to Doctors depending on their engagement. A few potential examples are as below.
  - **Shraman Aarogyam**: Doctors can get connected with this initiative for a noble cause and also get their respective healthcare facilities join the network of Shraman Aarogyam
  - **JIF & JAN**: JIF & JAN also get startups from healthcare sectors. These startups present opportunities for doctors to get their own startup ideas incubated and funded.
  - **JITO Youth & JITO Ladies**: Both of these wings of JITO have thousands of members spread across India which can provide the required exposure & recognition to the Doctors.
  - **JITO Professional Forum**: JPF is a vertical focused exclusively on Doctors, Lawyers, CAs, CSs, Salaried Corporate Executives, etc. This project can provide horizontal networking opportunities to Doctors to be able to connect with specialized lawyers, Bankers, Technology experts etc.
  - **JITO Matrimony**: This project provides Matrimony related network and platform for Doctors. This has been identified as a key pain area for many professionals given their highly qualified credentials.

## PROPOSED SOLUTION

- Create a repository of Jain doctors from across India.
- Over the next one and a half years, the focus should be only building this repository and restrict the value proposition to the above points.

## MTM SERIES 3 - MANAGING CHANGE & GROWING BUSINESSES IN CHANGING TIMES

Nahar JBN Mentorship Program came up with another program under MTM series which was focused on Managing Change & Growing Businesses in Changing Times on 28th February 2021. Shri Satish Parakh from Ashoka Buildcon was the speaker who impressed the audience with his thoughts, experience, guidance and how he was able to successfully grow a business into multiple domains. Key learnings from the session were:

- Change in consideration of volatile world has to be dynamic.
- Business Network can take you to the next level, no matter how big or small you currently are.

- Give more time in planning than execution, for effective and timely execution.
- Work like a T20 match. We know the target and keep on changing the resources and strategy based on the asking rate or the project requirement.
- Do not change your target, rather work on resource allocation to meet the target.

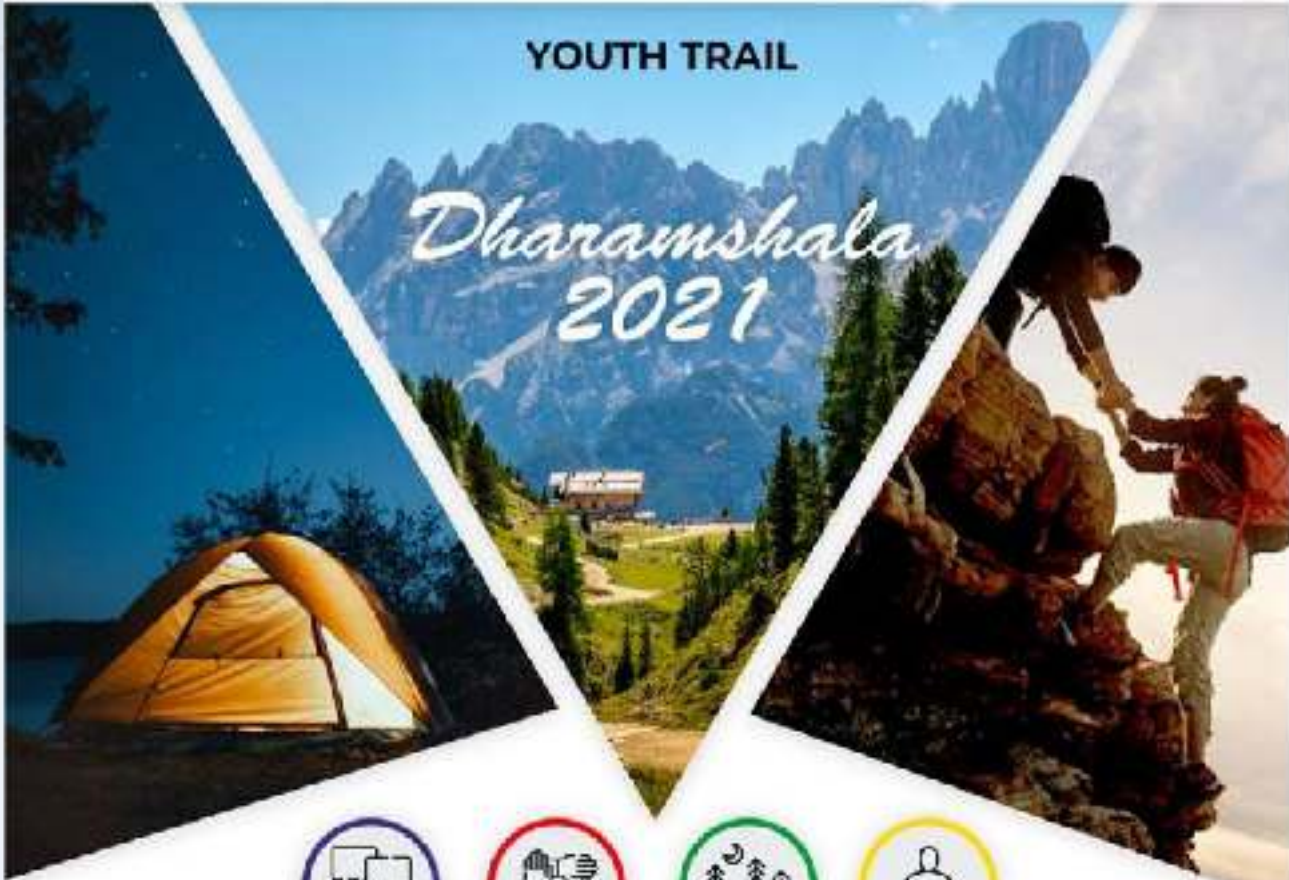

### “Union Budget'21- Simplified 'What's the Youth Getting?’”

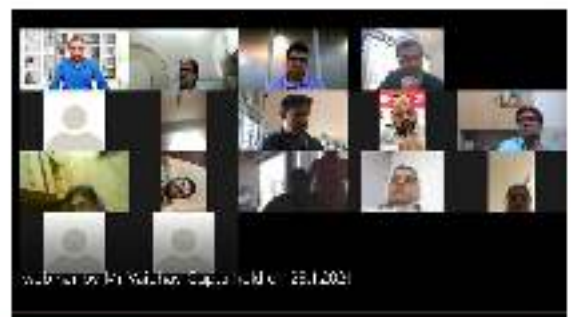

- Reduction of obesity assists in getting better pregnancy rates after infertility treatment.
- Long-term monitoring is a must to prevent medical disorders such as cancer of the uterus in PCOS women during their lifespan or of a pregnant patient for diabetes and high blood pressure during pregnancy.

Disaster Management can be defined as the organization and management of resources and responsibilities for dealing with all humanitarian aspects of emergencies, in particular preparedness, response and recovery in order to lessen the impact of disasters. Emergency managers think of disasters as recurring events with four phases: Mitigation, Preparedness, Response, and Recovery. Disaster management aims to reduce, or avoid, the potential losses from hazards, assure prompt and appropriate assistance to victims of disaster, and achieve rapid and effective recovery. The meaning of disaster, risks associated and preparedness needed to manage such situations was the key takeaway. The session gave a crisp action plan to safeguard against natural as well as man made disasters while it enabled us to think like a fighter rather than a victim. "A necessity indeed for one and all". Learning Takeaways were as per below:

- Saving and protecting human life;
- Relieving suffering;
- Containing the emergency - limiting its escalation or spread and mitigating its impacts;
- Providing the public and businesses with warnings, advice and information;
- Protecting the health and safety of responding personnel.






