

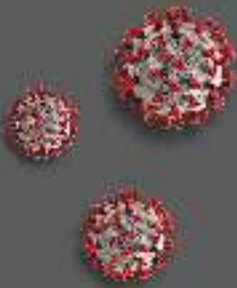

The service shall be available to the JITO Members and their family members from across the chapters. Chapters willing to avail of the facility have to nominate at least two members who shall be coordinators for this facility to the members and their families.

The details of the program are as below:

1. SCOPE OF SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY AHC: HOME ISOLATION - STAY I @ HOME

- Stay I @ HOME is a monitored comprehensive program of medical care and advisory services that is required to take care of COVID-19 patients for complete 14 days of home quarantine period
- The services are based on the latest guidelines from Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR)/ Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), which recommends Home Isolation for patients who are pre-symptomatic or have very mild symptoms, and are either positive or suspected of COVID-19.

7. Refund:

- I. In case if the patient is discharged within 7 days of enrolment on account of shifting to Hospital/Facility outside the Home, an amount equivalent to 50% of Unutilized services will be refunded. There will be no refund if the patient is discharged after 7 days of enrolment.
- II. As Isolation Kit is non-returnable, no refunds shall be made for this irrespective of the days of discharge.

- c) AHC Representative on receipt of call, as said above, shall initiate the patient assessment & on clearance of such assessment shall share payment gateway link to the patient. Upon confirmation of such payment, the enrolment process will be completed & all further appointments with the Doctor & other Care Providers as per chosen plan shall be initiated.
- d) In case any member is not able to reach the said Toll free number or are facing any challenges for enrolment, it is to be escalated to respective JITO Chapter Head who in turn will escalate the matter with AHC to the below person for redressal.

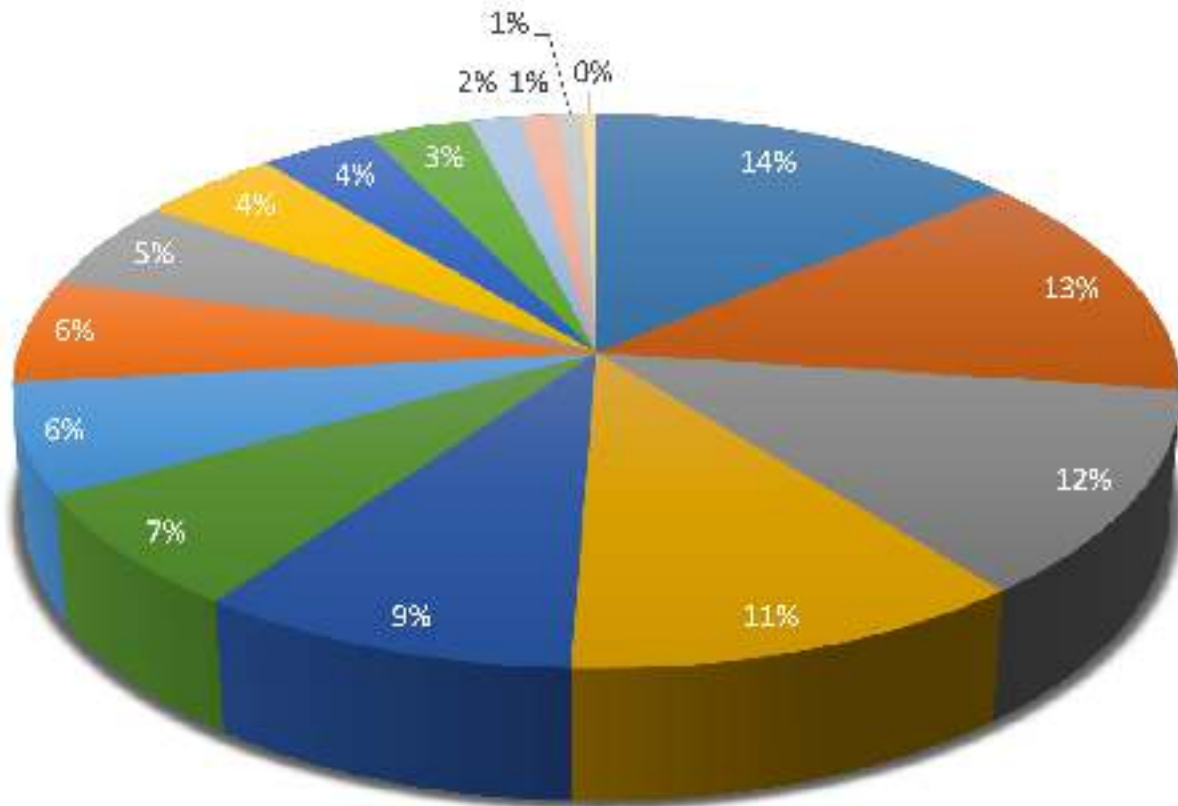

Covid Isolation Centre

JITO Ballari in association with Vijaynagara Sri Krishnadevaraya University and Seva Bharathi opened 50 bed Covid Isolation center at University guest house. The isolation centre rooms are very luxurious with attached bath room and balcony. It has very big dining hall and big open terrace at first floor. The centre is equipped with 24/7 nursing service, on duty doctor, breakfast, lunch and dinner with tea. Medical kit to all the patients will be given at the time of registration. Ambulance service for shifting the patients to district hospital in case of emergency. Yoga practice to improve the immunity of patients will be provided at the isolation care. To serve the society the charges from patients were minimal. In-house oxygenation plant cylinder

Since the plant was shut down for some time, with the permission from Government of Maharashtra, it has been operational. It can cater Filled Oxygen Cylinders against empty ones for free of Cost. This has been approved with the permission of Collectorate and other appropriate authorities.

FACELESS ASSESSMENT AND APPEALS UNDER INCOME TAX

A panel discussion on Faceless Assessment and Appeals Under Income Tax was conducted by JITO Professional Forum in association with Zones of Rajasthan, MPCG and NAPIS on 30th April 2021. 780 participants took part in this online event. JPT Chief Secretary Mr Tapasvital Deora welcomed all the guests. Mr Vimal Singhvi, Zone Chairman Rajasthan Zone, addressed the gathering. He mentioned that Faceless Assessment is the most burning topic and need of the hour. Mr Ajay Bohora, JTF Chairman and Mr Milind Shah, Director in charge JITO Apex were among the dignitaries who attended the event. Mr Pramod Jain, Project Convener Banking & Financial Services, moderated the event. CA Kamlesh Vikramsey, and CA Vinod Jain, Mr Kamlesh Sojatia, Chairman, JITO MPCG Zone, introduced the 1st panelist Mr Kamlesh Vikramsey, past National President of Institute of Chartered Accountant of India (ICAI) and a past President of The Confederation of Asian and Pacific Accountants (CAPA). Mr Kamlesh Jain, Zone Chairman JITO NAPIS Zone, introduced the 2nd panelist Mr Vinod Jain, a triple qualified professional and a chartered accountant. He is the Managing Partner of Vinod Kumar and Associates. CA Pramod Jain started the session by asking about what is Faceless Assessment and how it is different from previous assessment. CA Kamlesh Vikramsey explained that earlier we used to file income tax on paper and along with supporting documents. But from few decades, government has decided to digitize this process. Another aspect of Income Tax is assessment. IT Department wants to verify the returns, then assessment is carried out. Using technology, government has made this process faceless. Because of this, jurisdiction officer will not be assessing you. Assessment will be done by National e-Assessment center, New Delhi. In case of scrutiny, the case will be processed as per the laid down guidelines. As far as assessment and appeal is concerned, government has completely removed jurisdiction and made this faceless. CA



Pramod Jain asked if all cases faceless or few manual cases do exist? CA Vinod Jain explained that the government decided that process will be shifted to electronic assessment and it was announced in the budget in Feb 2016. Thought behind this was to eliminate harassment and corruption. Now this is a completely faceless assessment except few cases of serious frauds/major tax cases/sensitive cases/intentional cases/black money related cases. In some cases, if required, faceless assessment can be turned into in-person assessment after taking necessary approvals from higher authorities. CA Kamlesh and CA Vinod were also of the opinion that because of the digitization, all the information is available with the IT department, it is very important to fill in correct data in the IT return. Nowadays, scrutiny cases are posed based on the available data and filed IT returns. The participants asked questions about scrutiny, appeal process, time lines to be followed. The panel insisted on importance on filing correct information and being transparent to avoid any scrutiny or further complactions. All the panelists emphasized on being crystal clear, transparent and ethical.

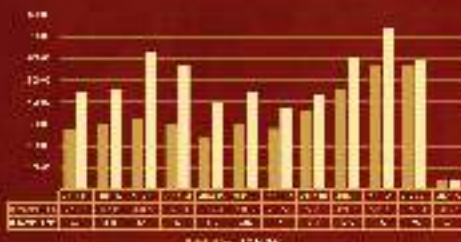

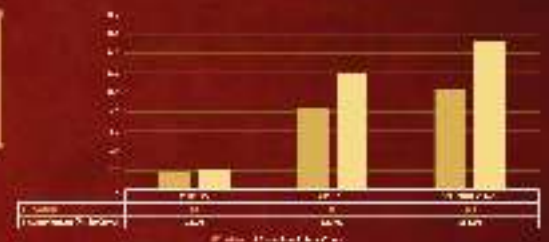

The coaching camp scheme would be supporting Jain athletes by subsidizing the coaching fees for them by 50%. The idea behind this scheme is to enable athletes to participate in coaching camps which may not be in their local vicinity as well as to attend highly specialized camps which may involve a foreign coach, etc.

Zone Meeting

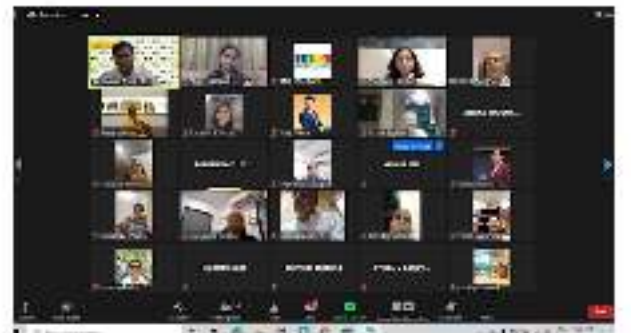
