Each and every member, chapter, zone and project contributed their best to create this memorable Symphony to empower women economically, enhance their knowledge and skills and do our best for Seva as well.

Team JLW realised its potential and the game changed! JLW delivered over...1000.....programs all across! We have created history! Let's continue to play the Symphony for impact!

जीतो श्रावक उन्नती

जीतो श्रावक उन्नती, जीतो का एक ऐसा महत्वाकांक्षी प्रोजेक्ट है जो समाज के अपेक्षाकृत कम सक्षम परिवारों की आर्थिक एवं सामाजिक उन्नती का एक सशक्त माध्यम बनेगा।

इस परियोजना का उद्देश्य समाज के हर जरूरतमंद सदस्य और परिवार को इस अभियान से जोड़ना है और उनकी तरफ सहयोग का हाथ बढ़ाना है। इस अति महत्वपूर्ण परियोजना का लक्ष्य जीतो अपैक्स और जीतो चैप्टर्स के सहभागिता से अगले १० सालों में रुपये ११०१ करोड़ की धन राशि को सधार्मिक भक्ति के सदुपयोग में आवंटित करना है। इस प्रोजेक्ट के प्रमुख कार्य इस प्रकार होंगे :-



आवास योजना:

- सधार्मिक आवास योजना: हर जैन परिवार का अपना एक घर हो।
- अगले 10 वर्षों में 10,000 सधार्मिक जैन परिवारों को आवासीय सहयोग प्रदान किया जाएगा। (कुल राशि आवंटन - अपैक्स 150 करोड़ - चैप्टर 250 करोड़- कुल राशि 400 करोड़)



शिक्षा छात्रवृत्ति:

- अगले 10 वर्षों में, प्रतिवर्ष 15,000 जैन छात्रों को एजुकेशन स्कॉलरशिप दी जाएगी। आने वाले 10 वर्ष तक *प्रतिवर्ष 15000 जैन छात्रों को एजुकेशन (10 वर्षों हेतु कुल राशि आवंटन - अपैक्स 150 करोड़ - चैप्टर 150 करोड़ - कुल राशि 300 करोड़)



ब्याज मुक्त उच्च शिक्षा ऋण :

- इंटरस्ट - फ्री - हायर - एजुकेशन लोन: प्रतिवर्ष 500 छात्रों को अधिकतम 2 लाख रुपये तक, ब्याज रहित लोन देने की व्यवस्था उपलब्ध होगी। आने वाले 10 वर्ष तक - प्रतिवर्ष 500 छात्रों को हायर एजुकेशन हेतु अधिकतम 2 लाख रुपये तक का ब्याज रहित लोन* देने की व्यवस्था (इस हेतु जीतो अपैक्स द्वारा *कुल राशि बजट 100 करोड़)



श्रावक आजीविका / आर्थिक सहायता:

- सधार्मिक मासिक आर्थिक सहायता - इसमें, उन जैन परिवारों को आर्थिक मदद दी जाएगी, जहां कोई कमाने वाला सदस्य न हो। खास तौर पर, वृद्ध, विधवा या विदुर व्यक्ति, जो तकलीफ से गुजर रहे हों।
- आने वाले 10 वर्षों तक ऐसे 4000 परिवारों को प्रति वर्ष 30000/- के जीतो अपैक्स द्वारा एवं प्रतिवर्ष 30000/- जीतो चैप्टर द्वारा आर्थिक सहायता दी जायेगी। (इस हेतु 120 करोड़ जीतो अपैक्स द्वारा एवं 120 करोड़ जीतो चैप्टर द्वारा कुल 240 करोड़ का बजट)



कौशल विकास योजना (Skills Development):

- स्किल डेवलपमेंट यानि रोजगार हेतु सक्षम बनाना : ६१ करोड़ रुपए के बजट से, इस अभियान के तहत जैन बंधुओं को स्वावलंबी बनाना है। प्रशिक्षण के ज़रिए उन्हें स्वयं व्यापार या रोजगार के काबिल बनाना है।
- स्किल डेवलपमेंट द्वारा ट्रेनिंग देकर रोजगार या स्वयं व्यापार हेतु सक्षम आर्थिक सक्षम बनाना एवं कोई भी आपदा के समय मानव सेवा ऐसे कई कार्यों के लिये 61 करोड़ का बजट।

जहाँ पर जीतो के चैप्टर नहीं है अथवा जीतो के छोटे चैप्टर अपने सहयोग की राशि नहीं जुटा पायेंगे, वहाँ के सधार्मिक परिवारों को जीतो अपैक्स द्वारा राशि आवंटित होगी। इसमें प्रारंभ में **500 पैट्रन** डोनर **1.08 करोड़** लिए जाएंगे, जिसका भुगतान प्रति वर्ष **27 लाख** रुपए (**4 किशतों**) रखा गया है, एवं अगले फेस में अन्य 500 पैट्रन डोनर लिए जाएंगे। अगले कुछ दिनों में इसकी पूरी विस्तृत जानकारी प्रेषित कर प्रारंभ किया जायेगा।

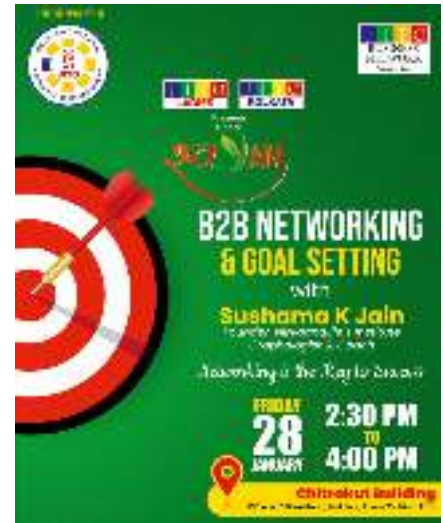

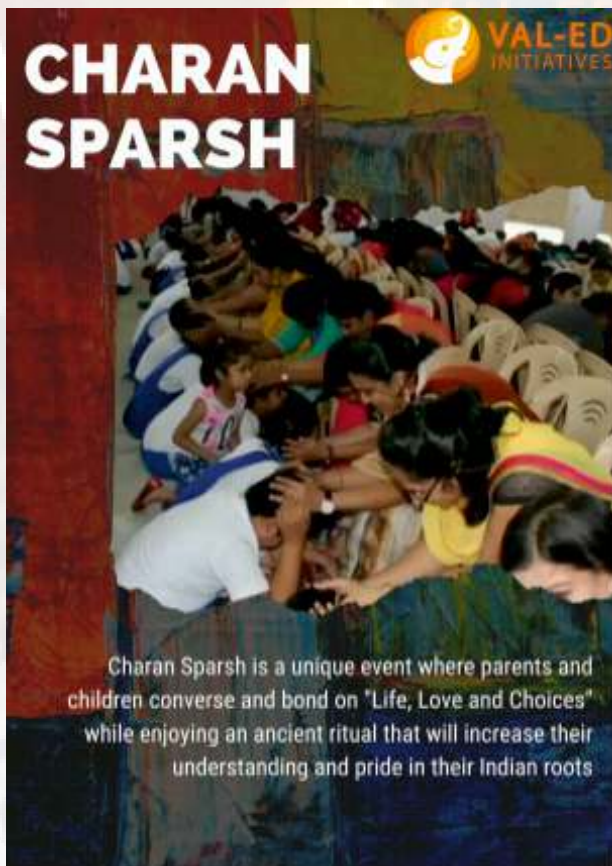

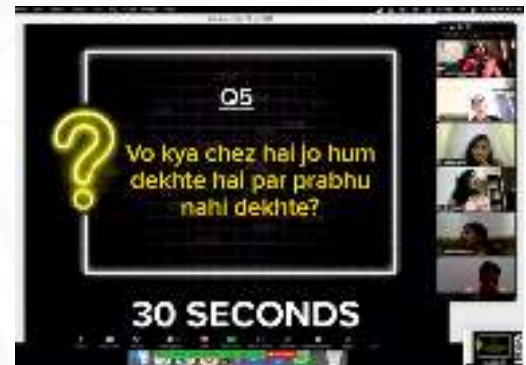
JLW BANGALORE | HEALTH AND NUTRITION

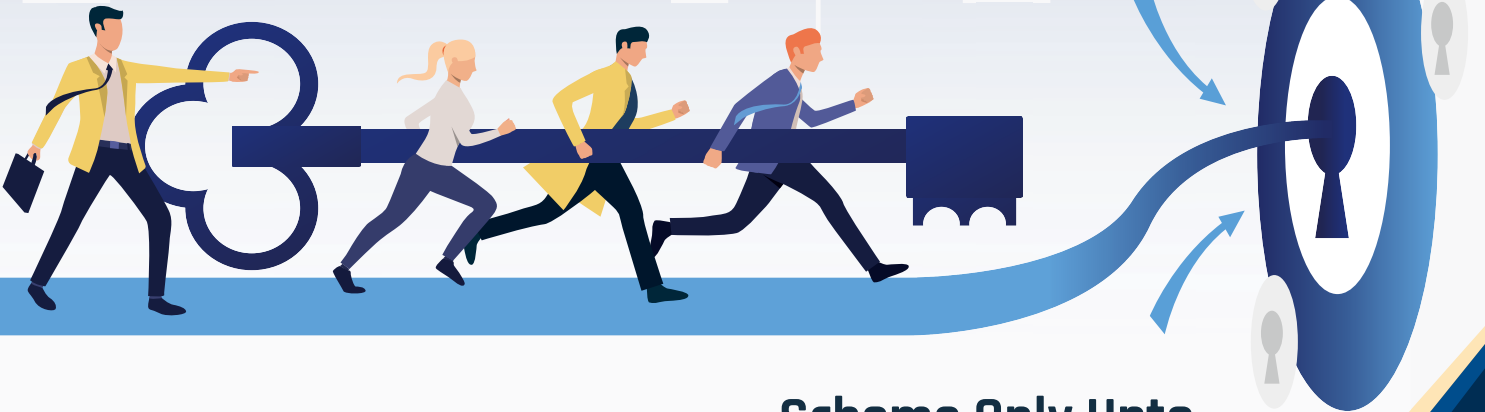
